Touring Personnel

The company tours 2 performers (1 M, 1 F) and 3 technicians (1 sound engineer, 1 light technician, 1 set technician). Lights and sound are operated by touring personnel. Both operating positions must have a clear view of the stage.

Setup and Dismantling

The get-in depends on the setup of the theatre. It can take about 3 hours, if the theatre has an appropriate hanging for the elements and help from in-house technicians. If special adjustments and floor stands or other equipment is required, setup can take longer. Light and sound set up takes another 3 hours. Teardown and packing take about 2 hours. Venue should provide at least 3 skilled technicians, 1 stagehand for set setup and dismantling, 1 specialized in sound, and 1 in light.

There must be a rehearsal before the performance.

Stage

- A black box stage is required
- A full black out (complete darkness) is required
- The performance requires raked seating
- The height above the stage should be at least 3,5 m
- Sides should be closed with black curtains

For a large venue:

(See Appendix 1 – Big Venue for more information.)

- Maximum stage size of performing surface is 1100 cm (width) x 700 cm (depth)
- Additional min. 2,5 m width of space on the left side of stage (or backstage) for storage of props
- 7 m x 7 m size of white dance floor
- 11 m x 7 m size of black dance floor
- 3 m pipe height for hanging backdrop
- 3 m pipe height (perpendicular to backdrop) for hanging set on the left side
- If possible, black dance floor also between the white dance floor performing surface and the audience.

For a small venue:

(See Appendix 2 – Small Venue for more information.)

- Minimum stage size of performing surface is 900 cm (width) x 550 cm (depth)
- Additional min. 250 cm width of space on the left side of stage (direct access to backstage) for storage of props
- 7 m x 5,5 m size of white dance floor
- 2 m x 5,5 m size of black dance floor
- 3 m pipe height for hanging backdrop
- 3 m pipe height (perpendicular to backdrop) for hanging set on the left side.

The staging items we bring with us:

- White Polyethylene (LDPE) Backdrop in 3 pieces (total width 7 m, height 3 m)
- White Polyethylene (LDPE) sliced curtains in 12 pieces (total width 5 m 7 m, height 3 m)
- 7 m x 5 m/7 m x 7 m White Polyethylene (LDPE) flooring

Items, required by the venue:

- 1x Disco ball
- 1x floor fan
- 6 sandbags

If the show is traveling internationally, it also requires:

- White plastic chair monoblock
- White clothes horse with wings

Lighting

Lighting control and lights, provided by venue:

- 21 x Fresnel 1kW or PC 1kW + Frost
- 6 x Zoom profile (wide angle)
- dimmable audience light (for instance 2 x flood light 1kW + barn doors)

- 708 Cool Lavender or 202 Half CT Blue
- 201 CT Blue
- 141 Bright Blue
- 106 Primary Red
- 228 Brushed Silk
- Frost: #119/L256
 - + "rainbow" (provided by company)
- 28 fixtures
- (20 channels)
 - + audience light

Sound

Sound equipment, provided by venue:

- FOH
- 2x monitors on stage
- 1x vocal microphone + microphone stand

Please note that a front of house operating position is required. Please hold off auditorium seats to facilitate this if necessary.

Dressing Rooms

Please provide:

- A dressing room for the performers. These should be non-smoking and private
- Showers with hot water


Timetable, Transport and Contact

Set up takes between 8 and 10 hours, depending on what the venue provides. Take down is 2 hours. Set travels by a car/van or as a checked-in luggage.




Appendix 1 - Large Venue
